Transformations is an exhibition of prints, textiles and other artworks created by clients of homelessness charity SHP (based in Kings Cross). The project is the climax of a nine month partnership project between SHP, The Foundling Museum and The October Gallery's Learning Department. This artist-led project explores the theme of transformations through photography, print, recycled constructions, museum visits and guided tours. The project aims to put the participants in the driving seat, creating a self-sustaining arts programme and a model for similar development in other organisations working with disadvantage groups. The project also aims to help raise a more positive profile of the homelessness community and its achievement.
